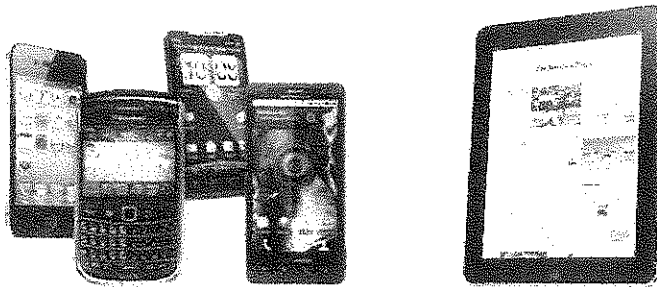

PARKING GARAGE SAFETY TIPS



TURN OFF AND CONCEAL ELECTRONIC DEVICES

TURN OFF LATTOP OR OTHER BLUETOOTH DETECTABLE DEVICES AS THIEVES MAY SEARCH FOR AN OPEN SIGNAL TO LOCATE CARS WITH DEVICES SUCH AS LATTOP COMPUTERS THAT MAY BE LEFT ON INSIDE YOUR CAR

ITEMS LEFT ON THE SEAT OR IN PLAIN VIEW ARE EASY TARGETS TO STEAL

BE AWARE OF INDIVIDUALS LOITERING IN STAIRWELLS AND IN THE GARAGE

REPORT ANY SUSPICIOUS BEHAVIOR TO THE GARAGE SECURITY AND POLICE
