Defining SARs With a Nexus to Terrorism

- Suspicious activity reports are collected every day in a variety of ways (civilians, private sector, public sector, law enforcement)
- A SAR is “official documentation of observed behavior *reasonably indicative* of preoperational planning related to terrorism or other criminal activity”



Terrorism-Related SAR Criteria Guidance

- Defined Criminal Activity/Behaviors and Potential Terrorist Nexus
- Activity/Behaviors
 - Breach/attempted intrusion
 - Misrepresentation
 - Theft/loss/diversion
 - Sabotage/tampering/vandalism
 - Cyber attack
 - Expressed or implied threat
 - Aviation activity



Terrorism-Related SAR Criteria Guidance

- Potential Criminal or Non-Criminal Behaviors/Activity Requiring Additional Information During Investigation
 - Eliciting information
 - Testing or probing of security
 - Photography
 - Observation/surveillance
 - Material acquisition/storage
 - Acquisition of expertise
 - Weapons discovery
 - Sector-specific incident
 - Recruiting
