## **Theft from Building/Bicycles 001<sup>st</sup> District - Central**

### **About the Crime:**

This alert gives notice to residents in the 001<sup>st</sup> District of bicycle theft related incidents which have occurred during the months of May and June. In each instance, the offender(s) targets and enters a residential, communal parking garage and takes possession of high-end bicycles.

### **Incident times and locations:**

- 1800 block of S. Michigan Ave – May 8, 2020 at 2:25 am – 3:00 am
- 2500 block of Dearborn St – June 3-4 at 6:00 pm – 7:30 am
- 2500 block of Dearborn St – June 6, 2020 at 8:31 am – 10:34 am

### **About The Offender(s)**

### **What you can do:**

- Pay special attention to suspicious individuals and activity in the area and alert the police.
- Call 911 immediately if you are a victim or witness to a crime and provide a detailed description of the offender(s) including any physical/clothing identifiers.
- Register your bicycle with the City of Chicago and the National Bike Registry. Registration can help the police recover your bicycle if it is stolen.
- Ensure your bicycle is properly secured by using a high-quality lock.
- Keep a file on all of your bicycles that includes receipts, serial numbers, and photos.
- Consider safeguarding your bicycle by attaching a tile tracker or GPS bicycle tracker.
